

Memorial Day Celebrated Next Month At the Eugene Masonic Cemetery



Memorial Day is a federal holiday in the United States, observed on the last Monday of May to honor and mourn U.S military personnel who died while serving in the United States Armed Forces.

Memorial Day became a national holiday in the United States in 1971. Although observances of the day honoring fallen soldiers go back to the Civil War era, it wasn't until 1971 that it was officially declared a federal holiday.

The Eugene Masonic Cemetery will observe the holiday on the 26th and 27th of May. Taps, guided tours, a children's "History Hunt," and more, will be featured. Further details will appear next month in this eNewsletter, in the cemetery's paper *Monumental News* and on our Facebook page.


